Dr. Turner-Addison concluded her report by commenting on a recent shooting in North Tulsa of Mr. Terence Crutcher, an unarmed African American male. She said that Mr. Crutcher was a father of four children, and that we, as a community, needed to focus on how to support the family. Dr. Turner-Addison said that education was the key to what plagued Tulsa.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORTS/PRESENTATIONS

Dr. Gist commented on the recent shooting of Mr. Terence Crutcher. She asked the district and community to come together and support the Crutcher family. She thanked President Dr. Turner-Addison for being a champion for the district's core value of equity, and she committed to the Board that she would continue to work tirelessly to bring that vision to life.




