#### **Drama**

Drama students will be exploring a galaxy theme. This will include stage craft, costuming, make-up design and performance. Campers will create a dynamic black light planetary performance for our final day.

#### **Dance**

Campers will learn dance history and choreography related to our theme of One World. Students will be exposed to various dance styles and costumes related to their cultural themes.

#### **Art**

Campers will experience many types of printing including foam plate, gelli plates, linocut, and screenprinting. Culture will be the focus of the art which will explore many themes including traditions, family, holidays, sports, religion, language, fashion, music, and food.

#### **Music**

Band students in 6<sup>th</sup>- 8<sup>th</sup> grade with previous band experience will learn new theory, enjoy different world music and fun pop tunes. By the time camp is over students may be on their way to a new career possibility.
