### Classes available-Please choose two:

**Drama:** Drama students will create shadow puppets, study Shakespeare's *Tempest* and create monologues based on famous art works that depict storms and water as inspiration.

**Music:** Using musical instruments, students will experience bringing a cold mass of lead, wood or plastic to life. All it takes is air and attitude. Find what instrument speaks for you and how you can express yourself through sound.

**Art:** Visual Art Students will explore a new art material and culture each day. Students will emboss waves on metal plates, sculpt figures out of wire and burlap, combine wind and water to create Feng Shui Chimes and celebrate Japanese culture making Koi windsocks.

**Dance:** Water can be calm or angry, big or small, soothing or tumultuous. It can conjure memories of warm, summer days or cold winter nights, freezing rain or times of drought. In this class students will be exploring the many ways our bodies can move, inspired by the many faces and forms of water.

Teachers are all Oklahoma certified teachers and professional artists. Many have exhibited nationally and are well known in the Tulsa arts community.
