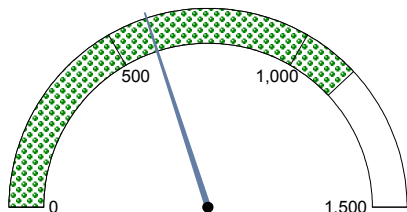


**MADISON MS****No Child Left Behind Act Annual Report Card 2010-2011****Academic Performance Index (API) and Accountability Data**

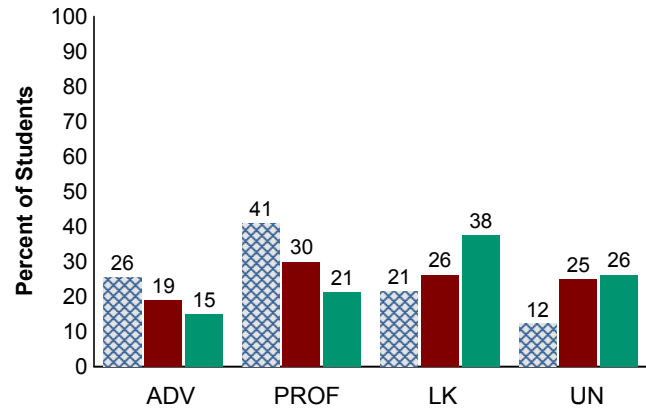
**State and District Reading Results**

All Students Tested



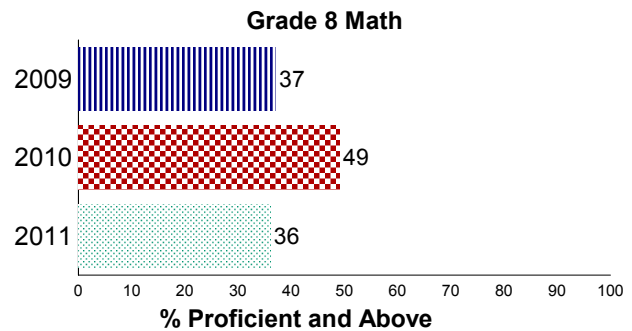
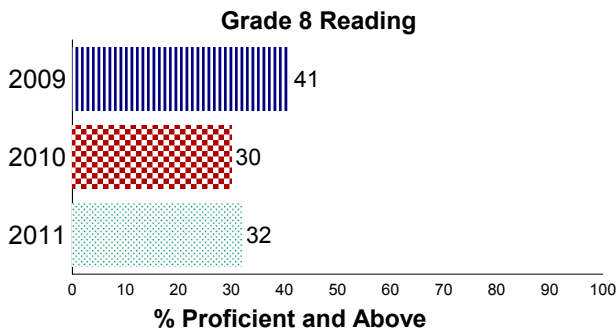
**State and District Math Results**
