E. CONSENT AGENDA

Recommendations submitted by Chief Human Resources Officer, Mr. Bill Naftzger

E-17. Approve additions to routine staffing items.

RATIONALE: These routine personnel actions implement the various human resources plans and priorities authorized by the Board for fiscal year 2007.

F. ACTION AGENDA - Discussion, motion and vote on each recommendation.

Recommendations submitted by Chief Academic Officer, Dr. Mary Guinn

- F-2.** Enter into a contract with the State Department of Education approved Supplemental Educational Service Providers, Reach for Tomorrow, A+ Grades Up, World Won, and Victory Learning Center. These four additional providers bring the total to 17 approved providers.

Payment for these services will be at the rate of \$1,284.64 per child. The total cost will not exceed \$1,541,568.00 and is funded through 8-11-5118-50-1000-3200-494-0000-000-05-093-

FURTHER RECOMMEND the attorney for the School District review and approve the appropriate contract and the proper officers for the Board of Education be authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the District. Contact person - Robert F. Burton, Sr.

RATIONALE: Supplemental Service Education Providers are a component of No Child Left Behind (NCLB) that will offer additional academic assistance to eligible children at schools in need of improvement (second year). The services are designed to increase academic achievement of children in schools labeled as in need of improvement. Twenty percent of Title I funds are mandated to be spent in transportation/supplemental services for identified schools.

- F-3.** Pay Heartland Consulting, Inc. \$15,000 per month from October 2, 2007, through December 30, 2007, to lobby members of the U.S. Congress for specific federal authorizations and appropriations, and to provide continuous advocacy and monitoring for Tulsa Public Schools in Washington, D.C., regarding all attendance educational grants, discretionary grants and legislative funding.

Total cost not to exceed \$45,000 to be paid from 8-11-0950-50-2340-3200-000-0000-000-05-093.

FURTHER RECOMMEND that an appropriate contract be prepared and that the proper officers of the School District be authorized to execute this contract on behalf of the School District.

RATIONALE: Tulsa Public Schools was recently awarded a \$12 million Magnet School grant facilitated by Heartland Consulting, Inc. Two additional requests for federal funding totaling \$3.6 to establish a campus police force and enhance the alternative education program are still in the appropriation process on Capitol Hill.

G. INFORMATION AGENDA

Recommendations submitted by Chief Finance Officer, Mrs. Joanne Lucas

- G-17.** File IRS form 8038-T and pay the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) on or before October 31, 2007, the sum (approximately) of \$50,000.00 rebatable arbitrage interest earned on the 2002B Series Combined Purpose Bonds issued September 1, 2002, in the amount of \$15,000,000.00.

RATIONALE: Interest earned on the debt service fund over and above the 2.580998 percent interest rate paid on the bonds is subject to rebate to the IRS, except that amount which qualifies as a "Bona Fide" debt service fund and which does not exceed \$100,000 in earnings. With the current trend of rising interest rates, the District has earned at higher interest rates, some of which must now be rebated.

The District employs First Southwest Corp of Dallas, Texas, as expert consultants to assist the District in minimizing the arbitrage rebate amounts required to be paid. First Southwest is preparing the 803-T return and has calculated the amount due from information provided by the District. The tax return and payment is due 60 days from the final bond maturity date (September 1, 2007), which in this case is October 31, 2007. The District sets aside money periodically into a "Rebate Reserve" from which to pay these required payments. The reserve is adequate to meet this required payment with a balance of \$113,325.94 as of September 24, 2007, and no payment will need to be made from the District's general fund.

- G-18.** Approve the lease agreement between Independent School District Number One and Resonance Support Center for an eight-month period beginning November 1, 2007, through June 30, 2008, for rental of the Pershing site at \$10 per classroom, \$5 per storage area, per month.

FURTHER RECOMMEND the attorney for the School District prepare the appropriate contract and the proper officers of the Board of Education be authorized to execute this contract on behalf of the District.

RATIONALE: The present office site of the Resonance Support Center will begin renovations as a result of being chosen for the 2008 Designers' Showcase. Proceeds from the tours will go to the Foundation for Tulsa Schools. The Resonance Support Center mentors 500 Tulsa Public Schools children in various schools through the Going to Bat for Tulsa Kids program.

**Recommendations submitted by Director of Bond Projects/Energy Management,
Mr. Bob LaBass.**

- G-19.** Grant a temporary and permanent utility easement to the Public Service Company of Oklahoma at Disney Elementary School.

There is no cost to the District.

FURTHER RECOMMEND the attorney for the School District review and approve the appropriate contract and the proper officers of the Board of Education be authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the District.

RATIONALE: This easement was requested by PSO to provide power to the new classroom additions at Disney Elementary School and allow for the service and repair of said lines.

- G-20.** Accept the donation from Bingham Realty, LLC, of property adjacent to the Lombard site (Project 12), with a legal description of "The East 15 feet of Block Seven (7), less the North 150 feet thereof, and Lot Nine (9), Block Eight (8), less the North 150 feet thereof, both in WAH-SHA-SHE ADDITION to the City of Tulsa, Osage County, State of Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, a/k/a 1123 West Newton, Tulsa, Oklahoma."

FURTHER RECOMMEND the attorney for the School District prepare the appropriate contract and the proper officers of the Board of Education be authorized to execute contract on behalf of the District.

RATIONALE: Acquiring additional real estate holdings at no cost to the District will enhance the value of the District's property.

- G-21.** Enter into a service contract for construction management with Trigon General Contractors and Construction Managers, Inc. for the construction of concession/restroom facilities at Milton and S. E. Williams' stadiums and the tracks at Hale High School, Central High School and Edison Preparatory School.

Total cost is \$2,200,000: \$800,000 to be paid from 839-1259-50-4700-4500-000-0000-000-12-037; \$1,400,000 is contingent upon the successful sale and receipt of 2008A Bond funds.

RATIONALE: Construction Managers have been utilized on various projects throughout the 1999, 2001 and now 2005 Bond Issuances. The latest project is the new Clinton Middle School.
