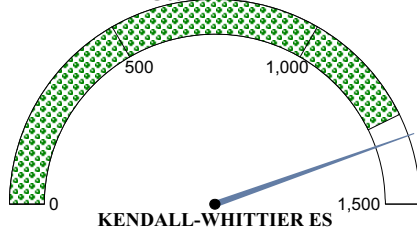


**KENDALL-WHITTIER ES****No Child Left Behind Act Annual Report Card 2007-2008****Academic Performance Index (API) and Accountability Data**

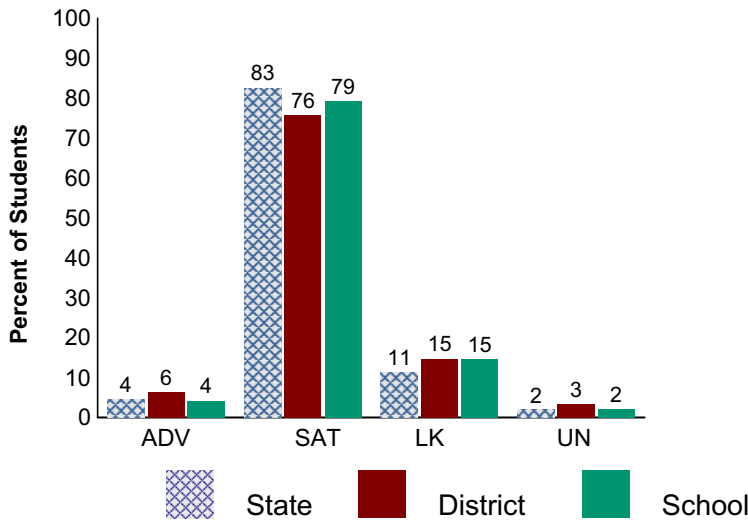

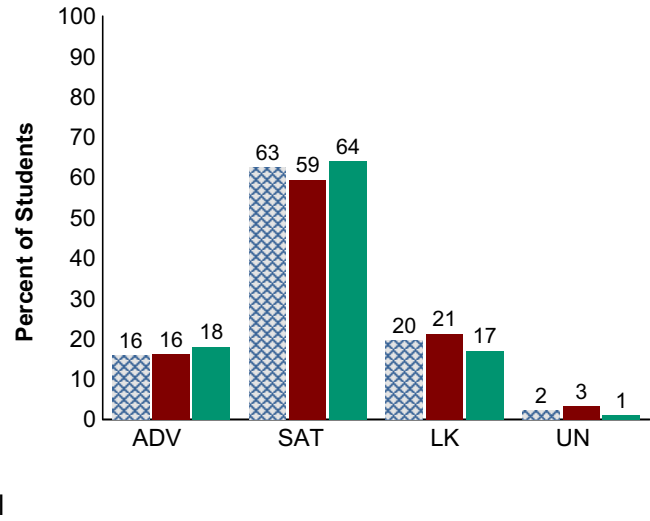
**State, District, and School Reading Results**

**State, District, and School Math Results**

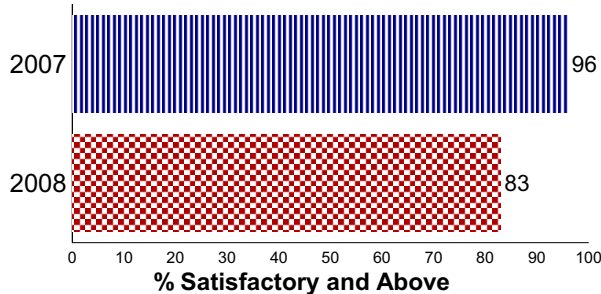

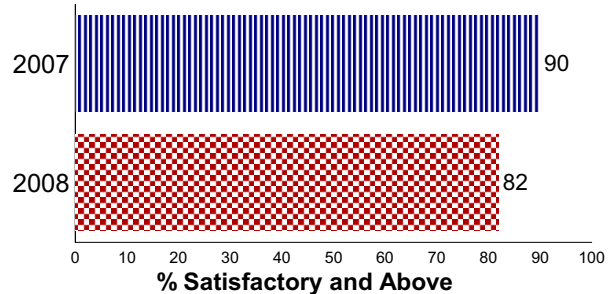

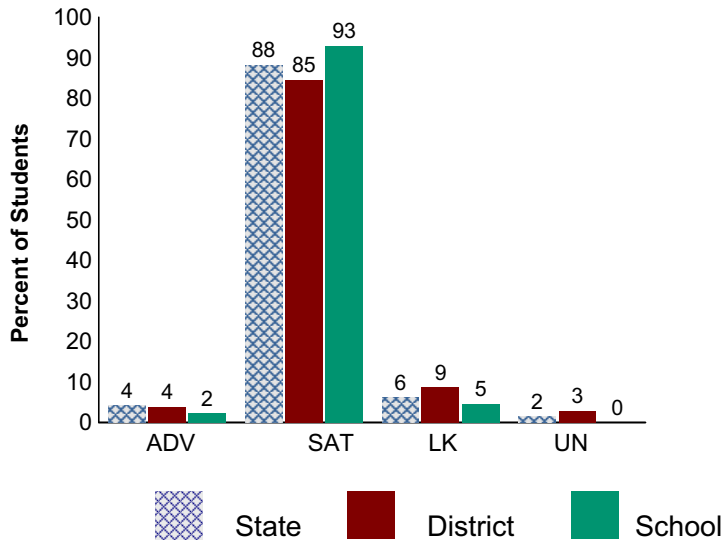

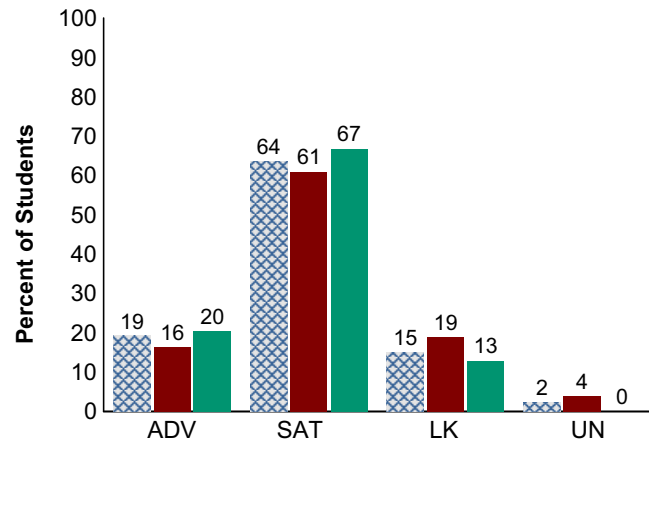

**State, District, and School Math Results**

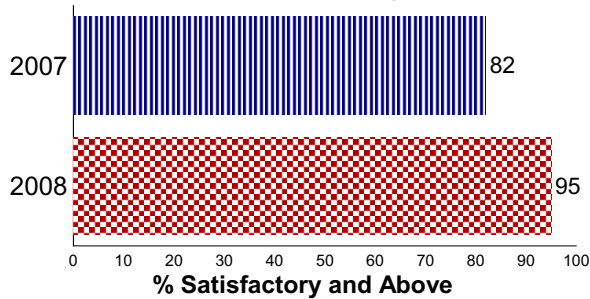

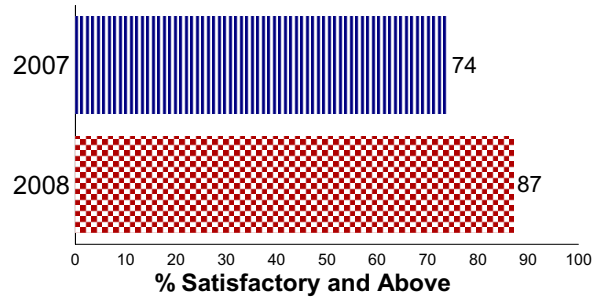

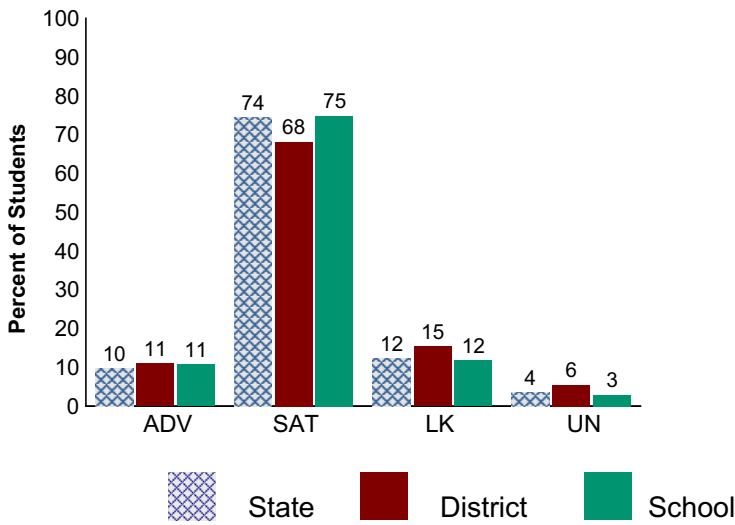

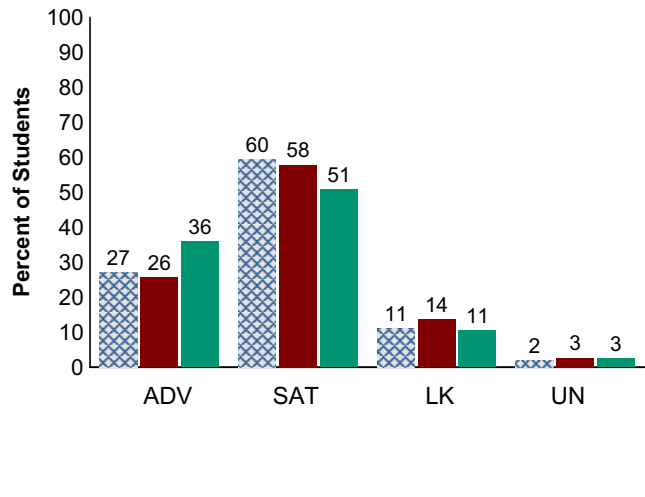

**State, District, and School Math Results**

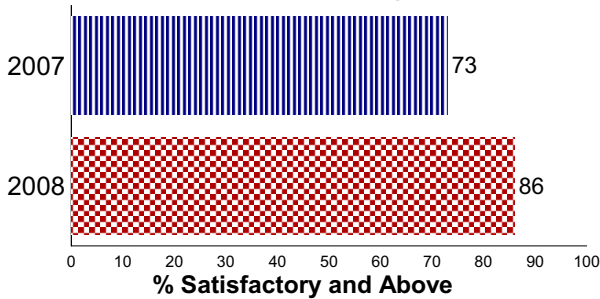

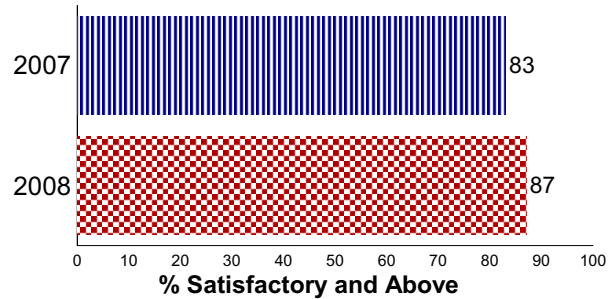
