At Booker T. Washington High School, the 2021 Bond for Tulsa Public Schools includes:



New tennis courts and stadium waterproofing.

- » Remodels for the school's science labs and investments in STEM equipment;
- » "Refreshing" the school's cafeteria with new furnishings to make it a flexible multi-use space for students, teachers, and support professionals;
- » Extensive safety and security improvements, a new roof, and parking lot repairs;
- » Repairs to the HVAC system to improve air quality supported by CARES Act federal funding; and
- » Upgrades to the lighting, sound, and curtains in the auditorium.

PROPOSITION 1: SAFE LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS - \$3 MILLION
