Tulsa Public Schools Enrollment Preferences

Neighborhood schools Prek-12th grade:

- Neighborhood students have a guaranteed seat
- Students with siblings already attending the school*
- Students whose guardian(s) work for Tulsa Public Schools*
- Students whose guardian(s) work at that school**

Charter Schools:

- Students with siblings already attending the school
- Academic Enterprise Zone (College Bound Academy, Collegiate Hall, KIPP)

Partner Schools:

Greenwood Leadership Academy

- Neighborhood students have a guaranteed seat
- Students with siblings already attending the school*

Magnet Schools:

Elementary Lottery schools (Mayo, Zarrow, Eisenhower, Dual Language) – within each quadrant:

- Students with siblings and who entered during or after the 2018-2019 school year have a
 preference if: during the year in which the younger sibling will be enrolled the older sibling will
 still be a student at the school
- Students with siblings and who entered prior to or during the 2017-2018 school year have a
 guarantee if: during the year in which the younger sibling will be enrolled the older sibling will
 still be a student at the school
- Out of district siblings do not have preference and can only be admitted through principal discretion

Middle School Lottery schools (Thoreau, Rogers JH) – within each quadrant

Thoreau MS

• Applicants who attend an elementary lottery magnet school

Rogers JH

• Applicants who attend Kendall Whittier ES or Sequoyah ES

Middle School Criteria (Carver MS, Edison MS)

- Applicants must be qualified by meeting these standards:
 - A minimum of a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale (cumulative previous school year plus 1st semester of the current school year)
 - No more than 10 absences during the immediate prior school year and no more than 5 absences during the application year
 - Standardized academic assessment score from the previous spring or current school year taken by the end of the application window (score must be at or above the 50th percentile in **both** reading and math)
 - Behavior (no out of school suspension or alternative placement for disciplinary reasons during the application school year or the 2nd semester of the previous school year)
 - Satisfactory score on the form completed by a minimum of 3 faculty members at the applicant's current school
 - Carver MS special condition any eligible applicant who resides in the historical Booker
 T. Washington school area and meets the criteria has preference

High School Criteria (Booker T. Washington HS, Edison HS, Tulsa Engineering Academy Magnet at Memorial HS)

- Applicants must be qualified by meeting these standards:
 - A minimum of a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale (cumulative previous school year plus 1st semester of the current school year)
 - No more than 10 absences during the immediate prior school year and no more than 5 absences during the application year
 - Standardized academic assessment score from the previous spring or current school year taken by the end of the application window (score must be at or above the 35th percentile in **both** reading and math)
 - Behavior (no out of school suspension or alternative placement for disciplinary reasons during the application school year or the 2nd semester of the previous school year)
 - Satisfactory score on the form completed by a minimum of 3 faculty members at the applicant's current school
 - Booker T. Washington HS special condition any eligible applicant who resides in the historical Booker T. Washington school area and meets the criteria has preference
 - Booker T. Washington HS special condition any eligible applicant who attends Carver
 MS and meets the criteria has preference
 - Edison HS special condition any eligible applicant who attends Edison MS and meets the criteria has preference

High School lottery (Rogers HS)

Eligible applicants attending Rogers JH have preference

All Magnet Schools

• Students whose guardian(s) work for Tulsa Public Schools have a preference only through the principal discretion process and provided they meet all entry criteria
